

Postdoc positions within SARChI Project on International Constitutional Law

- The SARChI Professorship in International Constitutional Law in the Faculty of Law of the University of Pretoria (<u>http://www.icla.up.ac.za/sarchi</u>) currently has Postdoc positions available for individuals in possession of a doctorate in law (LL.D).
- 2. The positions are available as of 1 July 2017, initially for one semester but with the possibility of an extension of up to 24 months in total. The stipend attached to the Postdoc amounts to ZAR 220 000- (net) per annum (i.e. ZAR 110 000- per semester). Postdocs are responsible for their own accommodation, travel and medical insurance.
- 3. Individuals who have successfully completed their doctorate within the past five years and have proven their excellence in writing and research in areas related to public international law can apply.
- 4. Successful candidates will be required to publish at least three accredited articles per annum and undertake various tasks within the SARChI project. The ability to work in a team, as well as a positive attitude to constructive criticism, emotional maturity and a desire for self-improvement are necessary requirements for the position.
- 5. Some additional funding is also available for national and international conference attendance or research visits, for those Postdocs who have proven their ability within the project to work independently and deliver high quality work in accordance with deadlines.
- Interested candidates should submit a (1) CV; (2) transcript of all university grades (3) and a 500 words summary of their research project to Ms. Pumeza Matwa (<u>Pumeza.Matwa@up.ac.za</u>) no later than 23 June 2017.
