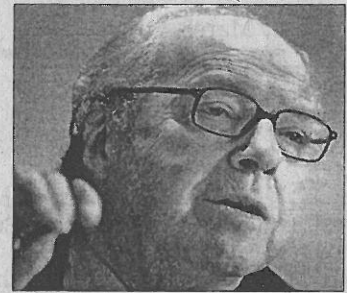

UN rapporteur on fact-finding mission to Kashmir

Srinagar: United Nations rapporteur on extra judicial, summary and arbitrary executions Christof Heyns Monday met police officials, lawyers, academicians, human rights activists and victims during his one-day visit to Kashmir on a fact-finding mission.

"My mandate covers all killings that are in violation of international human rights or humanitarian law. The focus of the visit is also on prevent of such incidents and that justice is meted out to the victims," he told reporters here.

During his visit, Heyns met police officials, rights activists, academicians, relatives of victims and sections of the society.

"I will submit a provisional report by Friday followed by a full report to United Nations General Assembly," he said.
